



Island of Hawai'i Famil Itinerary 17th – 20th July 2017 - 4 Nights/ 5 Days

Discover nature at its most powerful and raw on the inspiring Island of Hawai'i. You will find lush rainforests, lava rock shorelines, vast desert plains, snow-capped peaks, active volcanoes and endless adventures on this remarkable island.

DAY ONE – Sunday 16th July 2017

Afternoon: Transfer from Waikiki to HNL Airport for inter-island flight to Hilo Airport on the Island of Hawai'i.

You will have the afternoon free to recover from Saturday's Global Gathering Ball.

Overnight: [Grand Naniloa Hotel](#) is a seaside hotel and a place of gathering. In 1939, the hotel was built on breathtaking Banyan Drive at the tip of the peninsula jetting into Hilo Bay. This newly restored hotel includes 388 guestrooms with spectacular views of Hilo and is dedicated to creating a genuine Hawaiian experience where art, music, hula, culture and adventure share the same sky for visitors.

DAY TWO – Monday 17th July 2017

Morning: Hosted breakfast at Grand Naniloa Hotel. Check out of the Hotel.

[Blue Hawaiian Circle of Fire Helicopter Tour](#) - Witness the most geologically active environment on earth which has been continuously erupting since 1983. View lava flows, tropical rain forests and cascading waterfalls while learning about the history and culture of Hawai'i from the sky.

Afternoon: Transfer to Kona. Check in at [Sheraton Kona Resort and Spa at Keauhou Bay](#) and enjoy free time at the resort.

Evening: [Manta Ray Snorkel & Dive Tour with Fair Wind Cruises](#) - The Travel Channel calls the manta ray snorkel "ONE OF THE TOP-TEN THINGS TO DO IN YOUR LIFETIME". Enjoy a short and comfortable five-minute boat ride to Manta Village – located near the Sheraton Keauhou. You will witness the mantas up close as they grace the waters and feed on plankton. Swim within centimeters of one of the largest fish in the ocean, manta rays, this is an incredibly memorable experience.

Overnight: [Sheraton Kona Resort and Spa at Keauhou Bay](#) is situated on the iconic lava rocks of the Kona coast, overlooking historically significant Keauhou Bay the newly revitalized oceanfront resort flourishes with naturally landscaped lands. Puuhonua O Honaunau and Kealakekua Bay. Explore Sea Caves and Lava Tubes along the rugged Kona Coast and Observe Dolphins and Whales in their natural habitat as your US Coast Guard licensed captain talks story about the Island of Hawai'i's history, legends, and lore. It is a unique and intimate adventure in one of the most unique and beautiful places on Earth.

Afternoon: Check out of Sheraton Kona and transfer to [Hapuna Beach Hotel](#) for free time at the resort. Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel has a large, 6,800-square-foot free-form swimming pool, and a whirlpool spa, both overlooking the ocean. Relax by the pool or enjoy the Beach Bar. The pool is only steps from beautiful white sand Hapuna Beach, known as one of the best beaches in the world. An easily accessible snorkeling area called Turtle Point lets you see plenty of colorful reef fish and, often, sea turtles.

Evening: Hosted dinner at the hotel.

On seated four-man kayaks, you'll delve underground and float through thousand-foot tunnels, soar high over rushing streams, and float across the mountainside via elevated flumes.

Evening: Evening and BBQ Dinner at [Kahua Ranch](#). Located on the western slope of the Kohala Mountains, 3000 feet above sea level this private ranch provides a variety of landscapes - from grazing cattle, sheep and horses to vistas of ocean and coastal shoreline. Enjoy a fun filled evening under the stars while dining and watching the sun set into the Pacific. There will even be live music and line dancing! After dinner you will have a chance to participate in Paniolo (Hawaiian Cowboy) activities.
