



Flight Centre Kaua'i Famil Itinerary 17th – 20th July 2017 - 4 Nights / 5 Days

Rediscover a special connection to nature on this beautiful, island paradise. Renowned for its unspoiled natural beauty and breathtaking scenic wonders, the rejuvenating island of Kaua'i provides countless outdoor experiences for you to reconnect with nature, recharge and revive your body, mind and spirit.

DAY ONE – Sunday 16th July 2017

Afternoon: Transfer from Waikiki to HNL Airport. Inter-island flight from Honolulu to Lihue Airport, Kaua'i.

Check in at [Aqua Kaua'i Beach Resort](#) and enjoy free time at the resort and facilities and beach.

DAY TWO – Monday 17th July 2017

Morning: [Blue Hawaiian Helicopters Kaua'i Eco Tour](#) - Your journey begins with a flight to spectacular Hanapepe Valley, then continues on to Mana Waiapuna, commonly referred to as "Jurassic Park Falls." Next it's up the Olokele Canyon before moving on to eye-popping [Waimea Canyon](#), the famed "Grand Canyon of the Pacific" where you'll explore many hidden waterfalls. Then, the sculptural masterpiece of the [Na Pali Coast](#) gives way to the Bali Hai Cliffs, and the pristine blue waters of Hanalei Bay and the Princeville Resort area. Weather permitting; we'll visit Mt Waialeale, the heart of the ancient volcano. You fly into the center of the crater with its 5000-foot walls towering above and its 3000-foot waterfalls surrounding you.

Afternoon: [Mountain Tubing with Backcountry Adventures](#) - Take to Kaua'i's historic waterways in a mountain tube. The gentle flow of water offers a fun and relaxing ride through mountainside flumes and hand dug historic tunnels that emerge to stunning views of Kauai's beautiful and remote rainforest interior.

DAY THREE – Tuesday 18th July 2017

Morning: Check out of hotel.

[ATV off-road adventure at Princeville Ranch Adventures](#) - Start off with an exhilarating off road experience on our private ranch. Then enjoy two ziplines, and hike to a beautiful waterfall for a swim and a picnic. There are plenty of exciting dips, turns and climbs as you



roll through pastures and forests to untouched and historical locations. Then take a brief hike through the rainforest to an interior valley. Two fun, fast ziplines connected by a suspension bridge are waiting for you here. So get your zip on! Or just watch and cheer everyone on.

Afternoon: [Kilohana Plantation lunch and Rum Tasting](#) - Here you will enjoy lunch with views of Mt. Waialeale and the freshest, seasonal ingredients from Kaua'i's local farmers at [Gaylords Restaurant](#). This will be followed by Rum tasting at [Kōloa Rum Company](#).

Evening: Check into [Grand Hyatt Kaua'i Resort and Spa](#) and hosted dinner.

DAY FOUR – Wednesday 19th July 2017

Morning: [Captain Andy's Star Na Pali Snorkel BBQ Sail](#) - Explore one of the most beautiful coastlines on earth. As we head towards Na Pali you'll see views of Niihau, Polihale and the ridges of Kokee and have an encounter with the massive pods of Hawaiian Spinner dolphins. You'll see spectacular sea cliffs, numerous waterfalls and lava tubes. Kaua'i is the oldest of the main Hawaiian Islands, and this carved coastline is the result of nearly 8 million years of exposure to wind, waves and rain. After a relaxing and beautiful downwind sail, we'll pull in to a remote snorkel spots. Here, we anchor and passengers can get in the water, or simply relax.

Afternoon/Evening: Tour and dinner at [National Tropical Botanical Garden \(NTBG\)](#). Kaua'i is known as "The Garden Isle" for its tropical rainforests, fertile valleys and lush flora. So it's not surprising to find some of Hawai'i's most beautiful botanical gardens on Kaua'i. You can find three of the nation's five National Tropical Botanical Gardens on Kaua'i: the Allerton Garden and McBryde Garden on the South Shore, and Limahuli Gardens in Haena.
